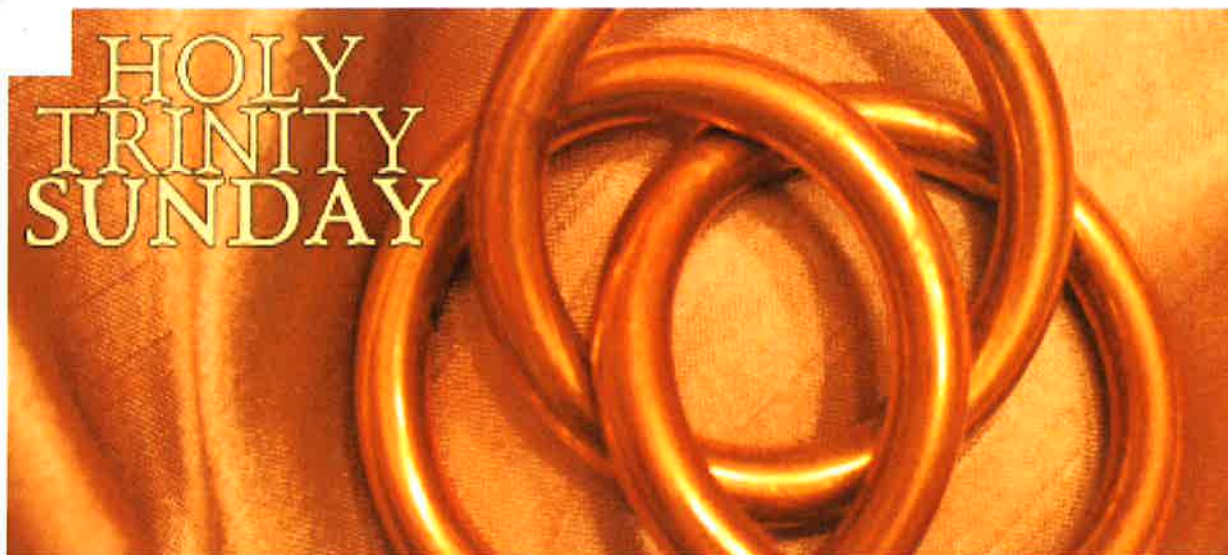

**June 13 – The Second Apparition-**The children gathered again at the Cova, this time accompanied by a few followers. Lucia's mother, a devoutly Catholic woman, did not believe that the children had seen Our Lady, and she constantly begged Lucia to stop lying. However, on this day, the children recited the rosary together and, at noon, heard what sounded slightly like lightening.

They knew that the lady was soon coming. When she showed herself to them, Lucia asked again, "What do you want of me?" The lady told her that the children should continue to pray the rosary every day and to add, after each decade, the prayer. **"O my Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of hell, especially those who have most need of Thy mercy."** She then told them that she would take Francisco and Jacinta to heaven soon, but that Lucia was to stay to establish devotion to "my Immaculate Heart." When the apparition was over, they returned home. Their childhood friends mocked them and parents made fun of them, even Lucia's mother. "If you want to eat, go to the Cova and eat what grows there. Maybe your lady will take care of you!" Lucia's mother was devoutly Catholic and was afraid that her child was lying or that the visions came from the devil. She loved Lucia, the baby of the family, very much and the two of them were close their entire lives. The parents of Jacinta and Francisco believed the visions were real.
