

Mass intentions-2018

These Masses will be filled on a first come basis in person only, requests by mail will then be filled with the closest dates to those requested in the order they are received.

We will in turn be offering these Masses for everyone as they will be offered every year for All Parishioners which of course includes those living and deceased.

Once everyone has had an opportunity to fill the five Masses, we will begin filling the remaining Masses for the year. We hope this will help to offer everyone the opportunity to have Masses said for their intentions while allowing for unexpected Masses to be said in a timely fashion.



In the event of an accident/incident, a report is sent to the Department of Insurance Services. Please, if there is an accident on Church grounds, even if you feel it is minor, contact the office and file a report.


