Fatima



October 13 - The Sixth Apparition

Today was a memorable day. It was raining heavily on the nearly 70,000 people who made their way to the Cova. Each one had come there to witness a miracle. Included in this crowd were media people from newspapers all over the world, there to document what would or would not happen. Pictures of the three children had already been in the news and the world waited to see what was to happen. They all trod to the Cova in the mud, torrents of little streams forming on the ground. Many had umbrellas, and some did not. Besides the rain, it was

cloudy and gray, not the sort of day one would expect a heavenly miracle. In her heart, Lucia worried, "What if the lady does not perform the miracle? What then?" The children came to the Cova and, as usual, led the rosary, saying the prayer at the end of each decade that the lady had requested they say. "O my Jesus...."

Finally, midday approached. Lucia told the crowd of people to close their umbrellas. Our Lady appeared and rose her hand, pointing to the sky. "Look at the sun!" Lucia exclaimed. Later, she had no memory of those words, as she was so immersed in what she was seeing. Up in the sky the sun began to move. Back and forth, up and down. It turned many colors – yellow, blue, green and purple. The people's faces reflected the colors of the sun. Then the sun appeared to plunge to the earth. People began screaming, kneeling, and confessing their sins. How could this be happening? Then, at 1 pm, as quickly as it had begun, the rain stopped and the sun returned to its rightful place in the sky. The ground and the people were completely dry and the sky was a beautiful bright blue. Here was the miracle the lady had promised to make people believe. The children could see St. Joseph and the Holy Child, who held up their hands to bless the world. There too was Our Lady of Carmel and Our Lady of Sorrows. The lady spoke: "I want to tell you that a chapel is to be built here in my honor. I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue always to pray the Rosary every day. The war is going to end, and the soldiers will soon return to their homes. Do not offend the Lord our God anymore, because He is already so much offended."

AFTER THE APPARITIONS

On April 4, 1919, the First Friday of the month, Our Lady took Francisco, the Consoler of Jesus, to heaven. It was just short of two years from the first apparition.

Jacinta's death followed on February 20, 1920. Before she died, Lucia said to her, "It won't be long now til you go to Heaven. But what about me?" Jacinta answered her, "You poor thing! Don't cry! I'll pray lots and lots for you when I'm there. As for you, that's the way Our Lady wants it. If she wanted that for me, I'd gladly stay and suffer more for sinners!"

On June 17, 1921, Lucia leaves her home in Fatima to attend school in Porto, run by the Sisters of St. Dorothy. The bishop gave her the name of Mary of Sorrows (Maria dos Dores) to protect her identity. She enters the religious life in October, 1925, and professed her religious vows on October 3, 1934. Lucia finally becomes a cloistered Carmelite on May 13, 1948. On February 13, 2005, Lucia died at the age of 97. On February 19, 1006, Lucia's remains were transferred to the Basilica of the Shrine of Fatima.


Francisco and Jacinta Marto were both beatified by Pope John Paul II on May 13, 2000.


Rite of Christian Initiation
