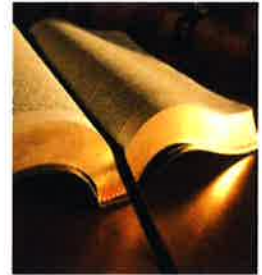

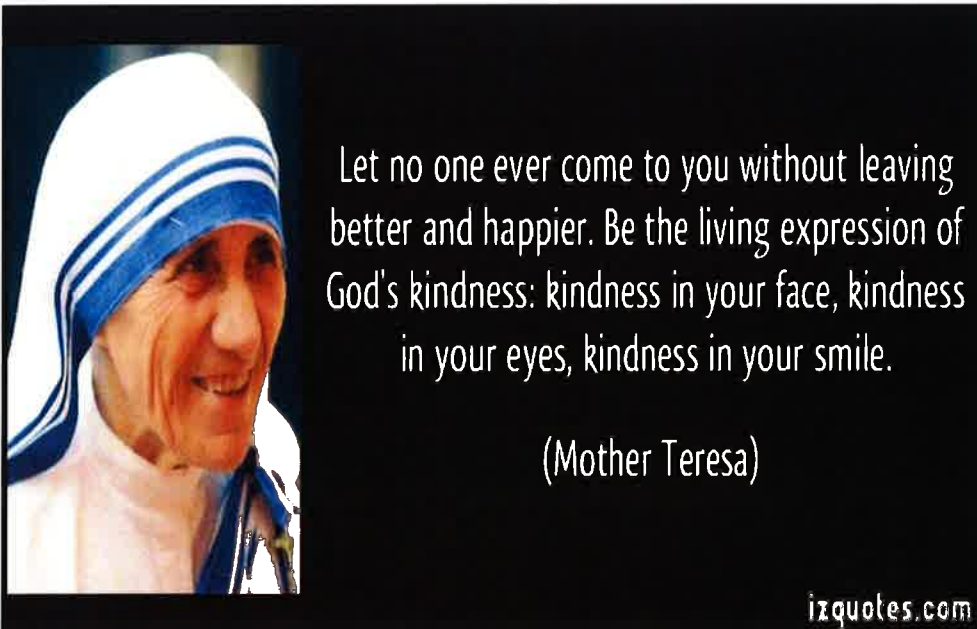


CALLING ALL DREAMERS
