St. Padre Pio Parish Unapproved Council Minutes August 14, 2018, Oakfield Site

We are a family answering the call of Jesus to be shepherds to his flock and to respond to his command: "Feed my Sheep."

Members in Attendance: Father Thaddeus Bocianowski, Deacon Paul Kulczyk, Barb Hendershott, Reg Barcomb, Linda DeVito, Debbie Greene, Diane Fiorentino, Mary Ann Dorman, Kevin Hendershott, Mindy Stempin.

Members absent: Debbie Armbrewster, Pauli Miano, Sue Zambito, Justin Calarco-Smith, Charles Zambito.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by Barb Hendershott. The opening prayer was offered by Deacon Paul. Father Ted volunteered to offer the prayers at the next meeting.

Minutes from the previous meeting: Motion to approve the minutes as written made by Kevin, seconded by Diane. Motion carried.

Open Forum:

Organization and Committee Reports:

Altar and Rosary – Diane – A & R will be participating in the conclusion of the celebration of the 70th anniversary of the Fatima Shrine on Sunday, Aug. 19th. The Rosary will be prayed at 7:30 am with Mass following at 8 am. Members will be carrying flowers in the procession to the church.

Men's Group – Kevin – We will be helping with the Faith Formation social on Sept. 16th with set up and providing and cooking the meat. Wine Tasting is scheduled for Oct.20th. We will have a similar program to the one last year.

Liturgy – Booklet for revised ministry guidelines is completed and will be distributed for implementation beginning with the next schedule in September.

Areas of Attention:

Community Building:

Coffee Socials – The social in July was well attended with about 30 plus people. The last early bird drawing will be on August 25th at Elba, after the 4:30 pm Mass. Mindy, Barb, and Chuck are scheduled.

Share the Journey – Mindy reported that the clothing give away was on Saturday, Aug. 11th. The need for volunteers for the Lending Closet is ongoing.

OACS elementary school project – Staff at the school are setting up a food bank for needy families. Right now they are helping 7 families; more may be added later. A box for donations of non perishable items will be at the Oakfield site in August.

Faith Formation: Mary Ann — Catechist Sunday on Sept. 16th will include a meet and greet for parents and teachers and a social/picnic. Participants are asked to bring a dish to pass. Meat and beverages will be provided. Virtus training will be held in Oakfield on Sept. 8th. The Diocese is in the process of revising their catechist formation requirements for the 2018 – 2019 year. Information is included in the August issue of the WNY Catholic.

Bible Study – Linda – We will be using the Word Among Us Press book, "Living in the Power of the Holy Spirit", by Rich Cleveland. Sessions start on Sept. 12th, after 7 pm Mass.

Stewardship:

Building and Grounds – Reg – Elba – The storage shed is in the process of being repaired. Reg and Deacon power washed and scraped the wood in preparation for painting by the work release crew from County Corrections. The doors have been repaired. Re-roofing will be done as a donation by R.A. Haitz Co.

Oakfield – In the fall of 2013, the parish embarked on a campaign to replace deteriorating window frames, restoration of stained glass windows, and replacement of existing clear storm windows. The ongoing project is being accomplished with the guidance of the Diocese and support and approval of our Finance Committee. In 2014, the St. Cecilia window behind the altar was done. In 2015, the three west side windows were completed. As

a continuation of the project, a three part proposal for the remaining eleven windows was presented to the Finance Committee in July. It was recommended that the two large windows facing Maple St., that are in most need of repair, be done in 2019. After some discussion, a motion was approved for Father to meet with the Diocese Building and Grounds Dept. and report back to Finance.

Oktoberfest – Nadyne was expected at the meeting, but was unable to attend. Deb reported that the cash raffle expenses have been made, and we are close to \$6000 in receipts. The basket raffle committee of Deb, Diane, Linda G., Chris Coffta, and Kim Gibson met on Thursday. Donations are needed from parishioners.

Old Business:

Parish Councils' Need for Review and planning — Deb distributed the completed administration section to council members for their review. Expect to approve at next meeting. Barb has asked for input for the community section from various groups. Linda reported that she would like to work on a history book for St. Cecilia and one for Our Lady of Fatima, similar to the one completed for St. Patrick's church in Wheatville. The St. Pat's book, containing pictures, was completed with the help of the historical societies of Oakfield and Alabama. Then to have an ongoing section on the history of the parish since merger. Mary Ann will be brainstorming with catechists and parents for the Faith Formation section.

Safety and Security – Father will be meeting with the superintendent of Elba schools to update the plan for using the church and social hall for emergency evacuations. He expects to reconvene the safety committee that met in July sometime in September. Evaluations by law enforcement and fire departments still need to be scheduled.

New Business:

St. Padre Feast Day celebration – Father would like to have a reception after the 10 am Mass on Sept. 30th. We need a committee. Linda volunteered to contact Bereavement and ask for assistance.

Pastor's Comments:

\$16,777.49 was received from Upon this Rock donations. We will receive monies every six months, dependent upon parishioners continuing their pledges. Diocesan assessments are being reduced by 10%. The goal is to have additional resources available to parishes. Bishop Malone has provided information on the financial status of the Diocese in his letter in the WNY Catholic, August issue. Bishop Malone will be moving from his residence, which is being sold, to the convent at St. Stan's. Bishop Grosz is now living in the rectory.

Adjournment and Closing Prayer:

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm. Deacon offered the closing prayer.


