How does Jesus lead with love, care and mercy?

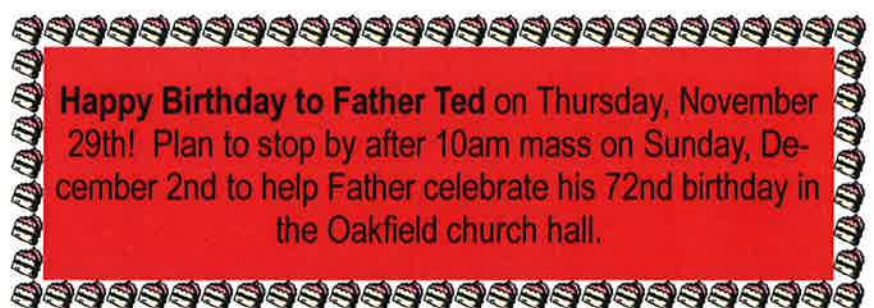
