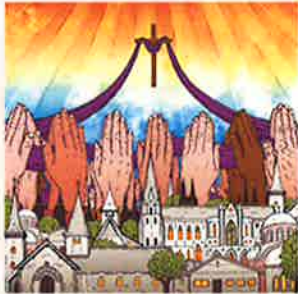

Justice, Only Justice,
You Shall Pursue



Ecumenical Week of Prayer for Christian Unity
January 18-25, 2019

Theme for 2019: "Justice and only justice you shall pursue"

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2019 theme has been selected, and finds its origins in Deuteronomy. "Justice, Only Justice, You Shall Pursue" (cf. Deuteronomy 16:20) was chosen for its powerful message of promoting truth, equality and unity.

How Old is Your Church?

If you are a Lutheran, your religion was founded by Martin Luther, an ex-monk of the Catholic Church in the year 1517.

If you belong to the Church of England, your religion was founded by King Henry VIII in the year 1534 because the Pope would not grant him a divorce with the right to remarry.

If you are a Presbyterian, your religion was founded by John Knox in Scotland in the year 1560.

If you are a Protestant Episcopalian, your religion was an offshoot of the Church of England founded by Samuel Seabury in the American colonies in the 17th century.

If you are a Congregationalist, your religion was originated by Robert Brown in Holland in 1582.

If you are a Methodist, your religion was launched by John and Charles Wesley in England in 1744.

If you are a Unitarian, Theophilus Lindley founded your church in London in 1774.

If you are a Mormon (Latter Day Saints), Joseph Smith started your religion in Palmyra, NY in 1829.

If you are a Baptist, you owe the tenets of your religion to John Smyth, who launched it in Amsterdam in 1605.

If you are of the Dutch Reformed church, you recognize Michaelis Jones as founder because he originated your religion in New York in 1628.

If you worship with the Salvation Army your sect began with William Booth in London in 1865.

If you are a Christian Scientist, you look to 1879 as the year in which your religion was born and to Mrs. Mary Baker Eddy as its founder.

If you belong to one of the religious organizations known as "Church of the Nazarene.," "Pentecostal Gospel." "Holiness Church." "Pilgrim Holiness Church." "Jehovah's Witnesses." your religion is one of the hundreds of new sects founded by men within the past century.

If you are Catholic, you know that your religion was founded in the year 33 by Jesus Christ, the Son of God and it is still the same Church.

Any kind of chili and/or dessert is allowed so use your imagination. (PLEASE let us know if your food contains items such as nuts, eggs or seafood as many people have allergies) .

This year, we will also be accepting soups, however they will not be eligible to win awards.

Spaghetti will be provided by the Men's Group for those who prefer not to eat chili or soup.

All chili must be prepared off site and brought in warm. We will have power strips for crock-pots.

You should supply at least one gallon of chili so everyone can try it.

The Men's Group will supply bowls, plates, spoons, bread and butter, oyster crackers, shredded cheddar cheese, beverages, and Tums or Rolaids, if necessary.

Chilis, desserts, and soups can be dropped off between 3:30 and 5:00 pm .

Sign-up sheets will be available at both worship sites so we will know how many people to expect.
