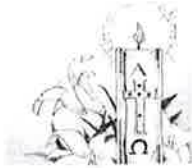

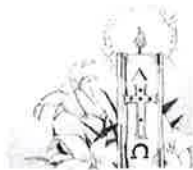

September 3, 2019, Oakfield Site

**Members absent:** Justin Calarco-Smith, Mary Ann Dorman, Charles Zambito, Pauli Miano.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Barb Hendershott. The opening prayer was offered by Father Ted. Deacon Paul volunteered to offer the prayers at the next meeting.

**Minutes from the previous meeting:** Motion to approve the minutes made by Kevin, seconded by Sue. Motion carried.

### Open Forum:

#### Organization and Committee Reports:

**Altar and Rosary** – Diane – Next meeting is a potluck dinner at Elba site. Need someone to lead the rosary before Saturday Mass at 4:30 pm. Membership is aging and there is a need to recruit new members. Leadership for Glimmer of Love is moving, so need new people to assist. Same is true for the Penny Social. These are two big fund raisers for A & R. Expect to have one or two donations of \$50 for Oktoberfest, as we did last year. Discussion followed on the need to recruit volunteers for ministries. Suggestion to focus on our different programs during the month of October, which is Volunteer Month. Kevin will prepare information.

**Men's Group** – Kevin – The Chicken BBQ was successful. The Pancake Breakfast will be Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>, and we are having Wine Tasting on Saturday, Nov. 16<sup>th</sup>, headed up by Mike Kowalczyk. As all the food was donated last time, so prices for tickets will have to be a little higher.

**Bereavement** – Eileen Kirkpatrick is the new committee chair. She explained the reorganization of the committee. Everything has been updated, from the set up, cooking teams, basic recipes, shopping lists, and protocols. A new booklet containing all the information needed for volunteers has been prepared with the input of committee members and Debbie Greene typing the information. The ministry has been self sustaining, thus we no longer ask for donations before each funeral as we did in the past. Monetary procedures will be changed having the checkbook in the office, Debbie receiving donations and preparing checks with Father's signature. Approval of expenditures will be by a board of Eileen, Alice Fagnan, and Judy Boyle. Debbie explained that the Diocesan auditors want all financial matters to be in the office and available to them on our computer. She said that a representative from our Finance Committee reviews all our transactions on a regular basis.

#### Areas of Attention:

##### Community Building:

**Coffee Socials** – Barb reported that attendance at our last two socials was down and asked if we should reconsider the type and timing of our socials. It was not clear in the bulletin that the social in August after 4:30 Mass was wine/beer rather than coffee, but people who came enjoyed themselves and stayed quite a while. Discussion on the importance of having fellowship events on a monthly basis from Pancake Breakfast, Chili Cook Off, coffee socials, etc. Will discuss schedule and type of socials early next year.

##### Faith Formation:

Mary Ann – (Sent report by e-mail) Parent Registration and Meeting will be Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>, after 10 am Mass; Catechetical Sunday and the first classes will be Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>. On Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>, all high school students will attend a Confirmation Preparation Retreat at Camp Stella Maris. Oktoberfest funds part of Faith Formation registration fees and the Confirmation retreat.

**Stewardship:**

*Building and Grounds* – Reg – The Spanish cedar used for the window frames is on back order, so the replacement of our stained glass windows in Oakfield is delayed. Ron Becker is following the work very closely.

*Day of Caring* – Had a very successful day. Reports from Rotary Club members that the workers were impressed with our effective preparation and the wonderful lunch.

*Required back flow device for water in Elba* – We are now compliant with regulations from the Village of Elba and the DOH of Genesee County.

*Musty odor in Elba Rectory* – Mindy – There is a musty odor in the rectory and wondered if a dehumidifier could correct the problem. The problem is worse in the summer, with some improvement when the heat is on. Members agreed to send request to Finance Committee for funding.

**Old Business:**

*Planning* – Linda – We agreed to update our written information on activities undertaken since our merger and formulate plans for the future. We haven't made much progress on completing the task, need to get busy with them. Debbie G. is the only person who has completed her assigned section.

*Council Elections* – Barb – Elections are underway for this year with 4 people needed. Please encourage parishioners to participate. Next year, Father has requested that we eliminate the site requirement and just nominate 4 individuals from the parish. It was noted that was the plan when Father Art was pastor when we merged.

**New Business:**

*Mass time on Saturday* – Mindy – Reported that she has had several requests to change the Saturday time to 4 pm. A number of people attend in Batavia where 4 pm is available. Winter driving is a concern when it is dark earlier. She wondered if we lose membership and monies because of this. Discussion on how we arrived at 4:30 after we had the survey just 2 years ago. Votes were spread out over the 4, 4:30, and 5 pm options. No one time stood out, so we compromised on the 4:30 time. Deb reported that we get the envelopes that people place in the collection basket at other churches regularly. When visiting another area parish for Mass, any envelopes placed in their collections identified with St. Padre Pio Parish are forwarded back to our parish, just as we send envelopes received from outside parishes. Discussion continued on how no one time will suit everyone.

**Pastor's Comments:**

Father commented that the Bereavement ministry is very important to the parish, and is happy to see the committee functioning so well.

**Adjournment and Closing Prayer:**

The meeting adjourned at 8:25 pm. Father offered the closing prayer.

**Next meeting:** October 29<sup>th</sup>, 7 pm, Elba Site.
