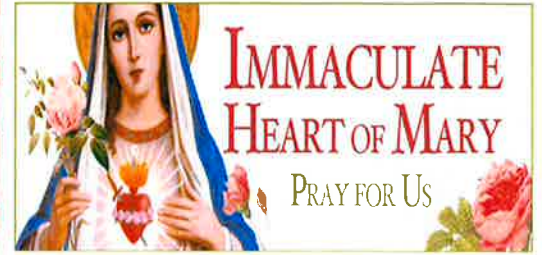
Ann Orlowski, who passed away in June, was one of the original founders of the group that provides a luncheon for mourners following the funeral of a deceased parishioner.

During her decades of volunteering, Ann expertly cooked and baked for countless numbers of our families.

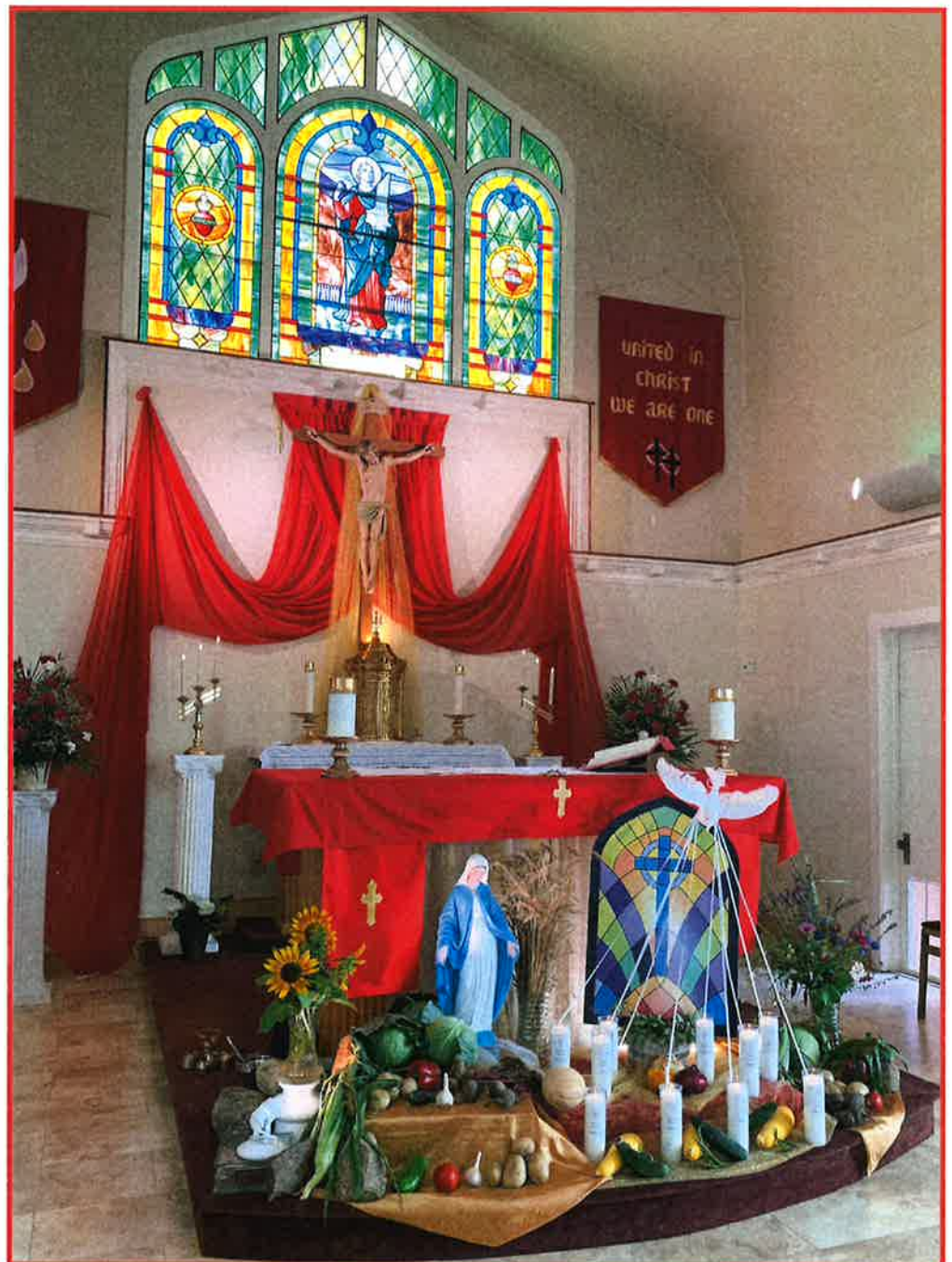
