November 15—Faith Formation

THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL : Matthew 25:14-30

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells a pointed story about three servants. Their master entrusts them with varying amounts of money. Two of the servants double their money, but fear gets in the way of the third servant. All he can do is preserve what he has. The challenge for all of us is to recognize the gifts we have been given and our responsibility to care for these gifts. That means caring for the world we live in and caring for one another. It also means having the courage to be our best selves.

EXPLORING the Gospel Message as a Family:

Help your child recognize his or her special talents. Encourage your child to use these gifts and share them with others. Spend some time having family members make pictures of themselves using one of their gifts- reading, playing sports, cooking, gardening, playing, or caring for another. Post the pictures as a reminder of this Sunday's Gospel.

PRAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY:

Make a litany prayer of all the many gifts and talents each member of your family possesses- such as honesty, gracefulness, intelligence, prayerfulness, athletic ability, kindness, and so forth. After each is mentioned, the whole family can say together: "Thanks be to God!"
