


mother of Father Ted, entered into eternal rest at the age of 93 on Christmas Eve, 2020. Please remember her in a special way, and pray for the repose of her soul.



Faith Formation

CHRISTMAS and EPIPHANY GOS-PELS: Luke 2:1-14 and Matthew 2:1-12 Christmas celebrates God becoming one of us and one with us. Jesus comes as an infant, placed in the care of a struggling but loving family. The Solemnity of the Epiphany celebrates Jesus as the Messiah of Israel and the Son of God. On Epiphany, a word that means "manifestation," Jesus was revealed as far more than the king of the Jews. Matthew's story of the visit of the Magi from the East makes it clear that Jesus came for all people who seek God.

EXPLORING THE GOSPEL MES-SAGE AS A FAMILY:

The lesson for the week covers both Christmas and the Solemnity of the Epiphany. Your family will be celebrating all the joys and wonders of the Christmas seasons. In addition to family attendance at Christmas Mass and Mass on the Feats of the Holy Family (the Sunday after Christmas), set aside some time to talk about what Jesus' coming means to your family. Ask your child to tell your family the story of the Magi following the star.

PRAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY:
Pick one of the feats days during the
Christmas season to attend Mass together as a family. Use the opportunity
to pay a visit to the Nativity scene at
your parish church and pray that you
will always bring the Good News to
others and reveal the love God has for
all people.
