
Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament is offered on request. Please contact the church office for anointing.



4th Sunday of Easter

THIS WEEKS GOSPEL: John 10:11-18 In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus compares himself to a good shepherd who knows and cares for his sheep. This image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd is one of the oldest images of Jesus in Christian art. The Good Shepherd cares for the world and demonstrates how everyone can care for the earth and its people.

EXPLORING THE GOSPEL MESSAGE AS A FAMILY:

While learning about Jesus the Good Shepherd, your child discovered that a shepherd knows, protects, and unites his flock. As part of understanding this Gospel, the class explored ways to protect the earth. Ask your child to share why Pope Francis added caring for Creation as a new Work of Mercy. Then talk about actions your family can do to be good shepherds by caring for the environment. Pick one or two actions and promise to help one another follow through.

PRAY TOGETHER As A FAMILY:

Pray together a few verses of Psalm 23: "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I lack. In green pastures he makes me lie down; to still waters he leads me; he restores my soul...... Indeed, goodness and mercy will pursue me all the days of my life; I will dwell in the house of the Lord for endless days " (Psalm 23:1-2,6). You can find the full text of this psalm in your family Bible.
