
Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament is offered on request. Please contact the church office for anointing.



We pray Blessed Mother will bless our efforts.





May11, 2021 7pm, Oakfield site

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by president Barb Hendershott. The opening prayer was offered by Father Ted in memory of all of the mothers of our parish.

Father welcomed Jim Coffta, the new trustee and Bonnie Madden, the new choir director.

Minutes of the previous meeting: motion to approve the minutes of the January 26th meeting, made by Diane seconded by Cindy. Motion carried

Open forum: Bonnie made an observation at a recent funeral. She was concerned about having to take the caskets up the church stairs. After a discussion Barb asked Bonnie to look into options and will report at the next meeting.

Organization and committee reports:

Altar and Rosary: Diane, no meetings this year. May have one in September. Officers approving spending. Donated to St Lukes. No rummage sale or penny social this year.

Men's group: Steve, approved up to \$500 towards this year's scholarship. Kevin H will be the representative. Chicken bbq will be Sunday, September 12th after the 10am mass. BBQ will be a pick up outside of the Oakfield site. Next meeting June 14th, 7 pm Oakfield.

Lay Vicariate: Debbie, attended a meeting by Fr Zielenieski about the Road to Renewal project by the Diocese. He asked our parish to come up with goals for our future. After discussion Father wants our number one goal to be getting people back in the church. Especially young families and children.

Administrative: Debbie, bell tower repair project approved by the diocese for 2022. Discussion on how to handle the new missals. Should we buy double and hand them out to each person or put them in the plastic sleeves like we have in the past. Decided to put it in the bulletin when we are handing them out and see how many we go through. Will also have directions on how to get the readings on your phone.

This will be Elba's 75th anniversary. We want to have a celebration this summer. Diane, Cindy, and Charles will try and get a committee together to plan something.

Bereavement: Eileen has the team leaders in place and will be sending out surveys to the helpers. No thoughts of starting luncheons any time soon.

Stewardship: Reg, Heating boiler for the rectory at Oakfield began leaking in March and needed to be replaced. Hot air furnace for the community room and kitchen at Elba also needed repairs. The parish received permission to continue with the next phase of the St Cecilia's window frame replacement and stained glass restoration. This includes repairs to the bell tower and belfry window. A few trees will need to be removed and some mortar repair will also need to be done. Oktoberfest: John reported to Barb that all activities including cash raffle are cancelled for this year.

Faith formation: Mary Ann, program has ended for this year. This year we had 10 first reconciliation, 8 first communion, and 5 confirmation. Families really stepped up to teach their children due to restrictions with the pandemic. They did an excellent job.

Old business: Barb, council elections. Linda wrote a form for the bulletin with directions and a ballot. Election process will begin May 29 and end June 30, 2021.

New business: Barb, Mindy brought up concerns about the set up of the tent in Elba. The audio system especially. Father is going to look into purchasing a new system. Mary Ann and Bonnie will look for volunteers. If we have the tent again in 2022 we may have Saturday in Oakfield two on Sunday in Elba to save on set up and take down. This year with painting going on in Oakfield it is not an option.

Pastors comments: Father thanked the men's group for cleaning up around the Oakfield site. His Golden Jubilee mass is May 30 at the 10 am and invites everyone to attend. **Adjournment and closing prayer**: the meeting adjourned at 8:30pm. Father offered the closing prayer in memory of our deceased mothers.

No meeting scheduled.
