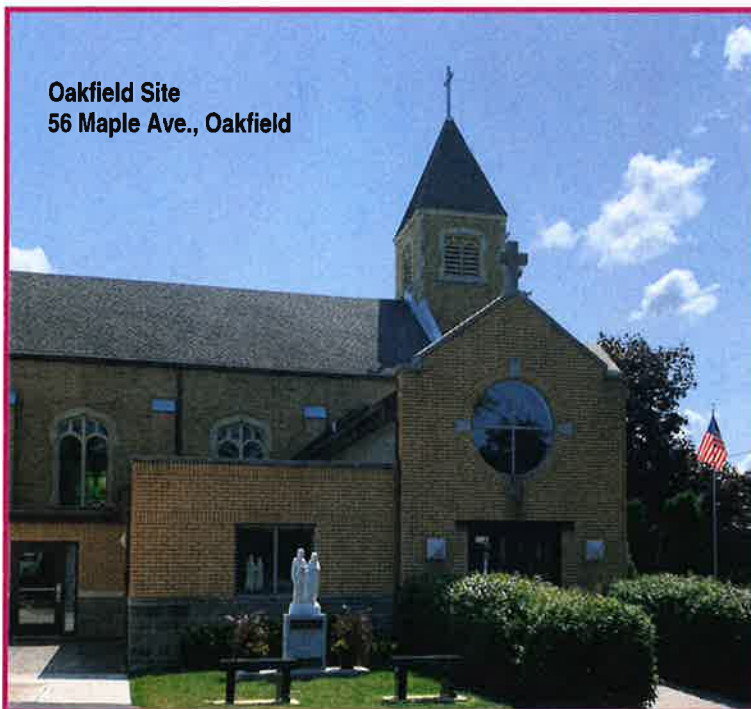

Our history of Our Lady of Fatima as recorded by Dorothy M. Coughlin, begins.....

The place is a pasture in Elba adjoining the Elba Central School; the year, 1946! The war has ended. Our servicemen continue to come back to their homes. A sense of sunrise, of new beginnings, pervades the American Day.

The dream, to found a parish in Elba, was Msgr. Edward J. Ferger's, pastor of St. Mary's Church in Batavia. The energy and willingness to be a participant in the vision belonged to his assistant, the Reverend Bertrand J. Gulnerich. The inspiration surely poured from the Blessed Mother under the mantle of Fatima. We were to become the first church on the North American continent dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima.

There were both fears and yearnings in the hearts of those Elba families scattered among the parishes of St. Mary's, St. Joseph's in Batavia and St. Joseph's in Albion, Sacred Heart, and St. Cecilia's in Oakfield.

Was it possible to have our place of worship? In our village! To be "gathered" among our own neighbors! To pray, to marry, to be buried from our own church? Christenings, first communions, confirmations, social gatherings, Vacation Bible School! A priest would grow to know us! No more long rides to Sunday morning mass!
