
Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament is offered on request. Please contact the church office for anointing.

Devotional Candles burn for 5 days and can be offered at any time for individual intentions with the suggested donation of \$3.00.



75th Anniversary Celebration of Our Lady of Fatima Church

Our history of Our Lady of Fatima as recorded by Dorothy M. Coughlin, begins......

The place is a pasture in Elba adjoining the Elba Central School; the year, 1946! The war has ended. Our servicemen continue to come back to their homes. A sense of sunrise, of new beginnings, pervades the American Day.

The dream, to found a parish in Elba, was Msgr. Edward J. Ferger's, pastor of St. Mary's Church in Batavia. The energy and willingness to be a participant in the vision belonged to his assistant, the Reverend Bertrand J. Gulnerich. The inspiration surely poured from the Blessed Mother under the mantle of Fatima. We were to become the first church on the North American continent dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima.

There were both fears and yearnings in the hearts of those Elba families scattered among the parishes of St. Mary's, St. Joseph's in Batavia and St. Joseph's in Albion, Sacred Heart, and St. Cecilia's in Oakfield.

Was it possible to have our place of worship? In our village! To be "gathered" among our own neighbors! To pray, to marry, to be buried from our own church? Christenings, first communions, confirmations, social gatherings, Vacation Bible School! A priest would grow to know us! No more long rides to Sunday morning mass!

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

About the Gospel: Sunday's Gospel introduces us to the gift Jesus wants to give us. He gives us himself (Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity) in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist (Communion). Jesus reminds us that he is the Bread of Life. Jesus wants to fill our physical and spiritual needs.

In Church: The Eucharist is our church family's special meal. Look for a special table in the church (the altar).



Question of the Week: Why does Jesus tell us that if we eat the bread he gives us, we will never be hungry? What does that mean?
