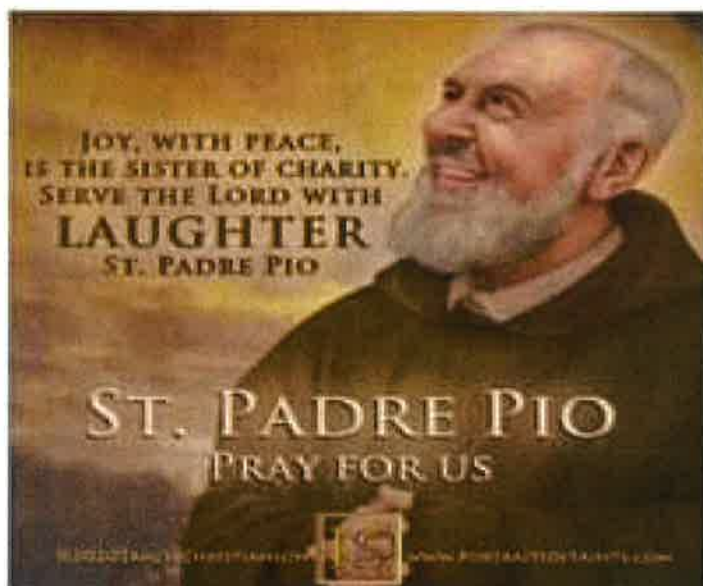
Jesus eagerly desires to share His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, in the Eucharistic Supper.
