
Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament is offered on request. Please contact the church office for anointing.

This week's Gospel: Luke 17: 5-10

In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus' disciples ask him to increase their faith. Jesus uses the example of a mustard seed to tell them that even a little bit of faith is powerful. Faith in Jesus gives the power to perform miracles and to recognize those we witness.

In Jesus' time, masters didn't sit down to eat with servants or reward them for doing their jobs. Jesus used this reality to make a point. His parable is critical of disciples who want to become masters of their fate or to lord it over others. Service is the ordinary duty of all Jesus' followers.

Jesus lived here on the earth 2,000 years ago. He was present to the Apostles and to all who saw him, heard him, or experienced a miracle through him. Before he left the earth, after his Death, Resurrection, and Ascension, Jesus left us the great gift of His Body and Blood in the Eucharist. 
