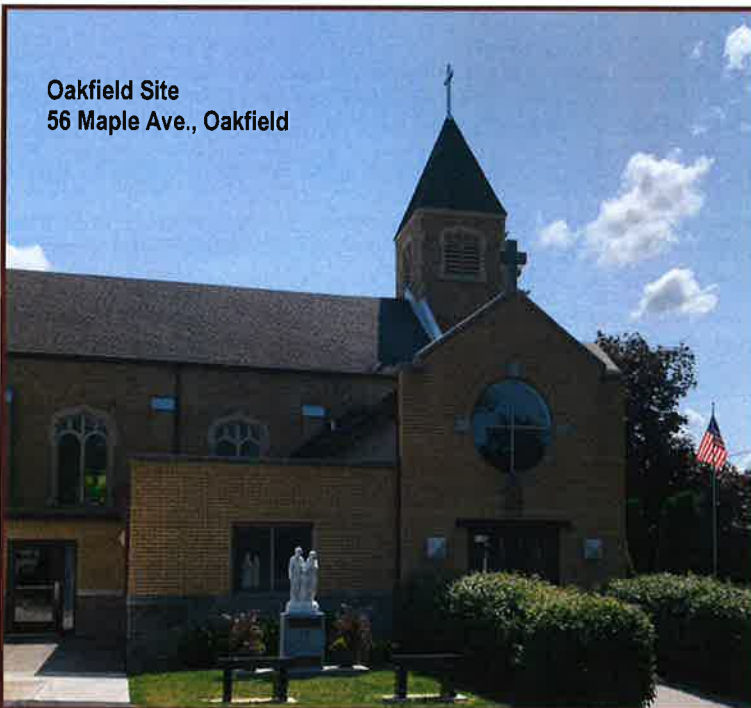

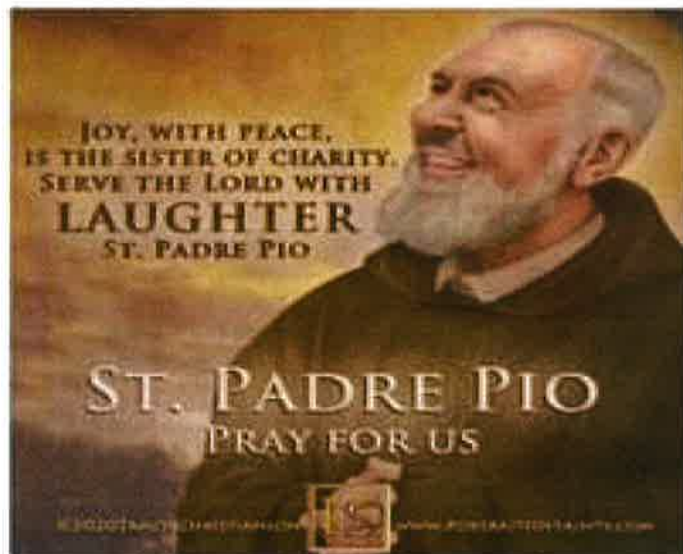

# Back To School Supply Drive

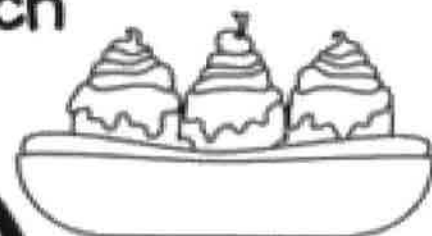
