
Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament is offered on request. Please contact the church office for anointing.





Bereavement Ministry Annual Meeting

August 17, 2023

Eileen Kirkpatrick, Chairperson of the Ministry, started the meeting at 6 pm with a general welcome and thank you for the volunteers in attendance. Father Matthew Zirnheld, Pastor in Solidum at Resurrection and Ascension parishes in Batavia, was introduced as a special guest.

Alice Fagnan, Eileen's predecessor, provided a short history of how the Ministry was developed and evolved over the years. In September, 2019 she retired as Chairperson. Eileen indicated that this meeting will cover information from that date to the present.

Father Ted made welcoming remarks and asked Father Matt to give a blessing. Discussion was suspended while volunteers enjoyed an appreciation dinner and dessert.

After dinner, volunteers each introduced themselves to the group.

An activity report handout was presented by Eileen. Highlights included the following: During the last quarter of 2019, three bereavement luncheons were provided serving 215 guests. In 2019, two bereavement luncheons served 140 guests before the Ministry was forced to close due to COVID. Luncheons resumed in 2022, during which we served 470 guests at eight events. So far in 2023, there have been five luncheons serving 270 guests. During the COVID pause, administrative activities continued. Likewise, since luncheons resumed, there have been minor changes to the menus and procedures we follow to prepare for and serve the meals.

A review of Ministry finances was presented. The Ministry is self-sustaining, meaning that our expenses for providing luncheons is offset by the \$3 per person charge for the meals and donations made by families of the deceased, along with various other contributions. An updated cost analysis will be completed due to the rising costs we have experienced post-COVID. Discussion ensued regarding the potential need to increase our per person charge to the \$3.50 to \$5.00 range. A suggestion was made that an announcement could be placed in the bulletin

reminding people that if they are not able to volunteer for the Ministry, they can still make donations directed to the Bereavement fund.

General discussion followed the financial review. Ideas were generated regarding how to recruit new volunteers for the future, and the need to establish "back ups" for all team leaders and roles. Consensus was reached that alternative menu items could be made available if we need to deviate from the standard menu, and numerous suggestions came forward. It was acknowledged that recipes will need to be standardized for all teams to use, and that the alternative menu items need to be cost neutral. Volunteers expressed that we all work together very well and that everyone is willing to be flexible when needed. A potential need to repair or replace our large refrigerator was identified, along with suggestions on how to fund replacement. Potential changes were suggested regarding the Ministry handbook, as well. All volunteers were encouraged to offer their additional ideas, suggestions or concerns to Eileen at any time.

Regarding the future of our Ministry, Eileen acknowledged that we simply do not know what will happen as our Family of parishes develops on the Road to Renewal. Those decisions have not been made yet by the Diocese and discussions have not really taken place either. Father Matt offered that this is a 6 year process and advised that we should continue to do what we are doing. Father Ted added that rumors about decisions are simply gossip, but that as soon as the Diocese provides information, he will share it with our entire congregation.

Based on the suggestions and comments from the meeting, Eileen will be updating the Ministry handbook during the next few months, together with the Volunteer lists, and insure that all volunteers get copies.

Thank you's were offered to several volunteers who were instrumental in preparing our dinner and helping to make this long-overdue meeting a success. Most importantly, the Bereavement Ministry volunteers were thanked and reminded that their efforts are appreciated by our parish families and our church community.

Father Ted offered closing remarks and a final prayer.

The meeting ended at 8 pm.




