



# This Sunday's Gospel: John 12:20-33

In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus faces religious leaders who are plotting against him. Many Jews and Greeks in Jerusalem were coming to him, and this angered Jesus' opponents. Jesus explains his fate by using the parable of a grain of wheat falling to the ground. Unless it dies, it remains a single grain. If the seed dies, it will produce a rich harvest.

#### **Pray Together**

One evening before the family meal, stand around the table and give each person a small piece of bread. Ask each person to imagine how simple seeds planted in the soil became this delicious bread. Let each member of the family say a simple thank-you prayer for the life and Death of Jesus. Then pray the Lord's Prayer together, eat the pieces of bread, and enjoy the meal.

# March 17, 2024 • 5th Sunday of Lent



I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the desert, but they died. This is the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die.

In the Book of Exodus, the Israelites had been freed from slavery in Egypt and were traveling through the desert to get to the land that God had promised them. When they complained that there was no food to eat, God made manna appear. Manna was a bread-like substance that continued to appear for the whole forty years that the Israelites wandered in the desert.

As Catholics, we believe that this manna foreshadowed the Eucharist. Just as God gave the Israelites physical food, he gives us spiritual food in the Eucharist. And although we eat physical food and still die, Jesus tells us that the spiritual food of the Eucharist will make us live forever. The bread, which is the Body of Christ, feeds our souls in such a way as to prepare us for eternal life—if we follow the commandments and teachings of our Church. If we stay in God's friendship, especially through the grace we receive in the Eucharist, we will enter the eternal life of Heaven that Jesus promises to us.




